Dear Parents;

1. Thursday November 1, 2007 – Wear your Poppy !

Please wear a poppy on your uniform from November 1st until November 11th , It is worn on the left side. It is a good idea to wear a poppy even when you don't have your uniform on.

2. Saturday, Sunday October 27th and 28th, 2007: Poppy drive at Deerfoot Outlet Mall.

We need cadets to volunteer to help out for these two days. Cadets who are in the band and guard are asked to sign up for the Saturday so that they can attend band and guard training on Sunday. Cadets are required to be at Chapelhow Legion (606 38th Ave NE) by 9:30am on Saturday and 11:00am on Sunday. Pickup time at the legion for both days is 3:00pm. From November 8th until March 6, 2008 Cadets will wear their White Corps T-Shirt under their blue uniform shirt. This is the cadets' winter dress.
